R1850 fee for the course.

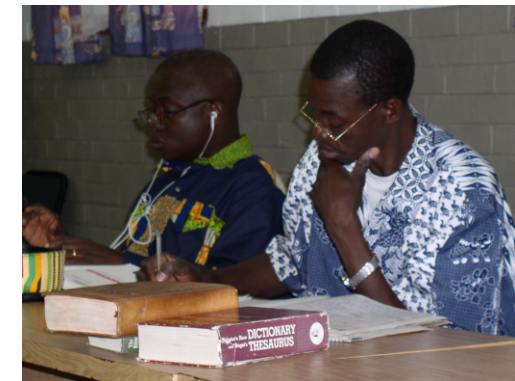
Discounts At early registration by 15 October 2007 you qualify for a 10% discount.

The fees cover accommodation, all meals, field trips and materials. Accommodation is dormitory style with ablution blocks. Sleeping bags, linnen and a pillow is provided but you can bring your own if you prefer so.

The course is held at Altelekker Youth Camp, located between Pretoria and Johannesburg / Gauteng.
